Enrollment of a student for the 2025/2026 academic year requires payment of the following: Registration Fees, Building and Maintenance Fund, PTO Membership and Annual Tuition Fees (amounts are per student and in Euro).

Schedule of payments

All Registration Fees and the Building Fund are due upon enrollment. All remaining Tuition & Optional Fees can be paid in one of the following three ways:

1. Early payment in full by May 5, 2025 (with 1% discount on Tuition)
2. Full payment by August 25, 2025
3. Payment 60% by August 25, 2025 and 40% by December 1, 2025 (+ 4% on any outstanding balance after August 25, 2025)

Multiple child discounts: Families paying the "private rates" will receive a € 500 reduction in tuition for the second child attending ASM and a reduction of € 1,000 from the third child in attendance at ASM.

Families who failed to finalize re-enrollment by March 4th, will be charged with a late fee of € 500 per student.

* EC1 – EC2 students will be required to pay the New Student Admission Fee (€ 5,000) when they enter in Kindergarten.

† Students enrolled in the Italian prep program will be assessed exam fees for the Idoneita' and terza media exams.

‡ A personal laptop computer is required for all students enrolled in grades 6-12. If not leasing via ASM, please contact the ASM Helpdesk for minimum hardware and software requirements.

§ Students enrolled in the International Baccalaureate Diploma program are required to pay additional exam fees as determined annually by the IB Office in Geneva, Switzerland.



ASM Policies on Financial Regulations

- 4.5.1 Payments must be made in Euro and will be directed to the school's Business Office and will be accepted in accordance with current legal limitations. Payments by check must be in the name of the American School of Milan and must be non-transferable.
- 4.5.3 A new family will be assured a place at ASM only upon acceptance and payment of the application, registration, new student fees and the building and maintenance fund charges.
- 4.5.4 The Annual Enrollment fee, which must accompany the enrollment contract, is non-refundable except when the student is not accepted by ASM; payment of the Annual Enrollment Fee does not assure acceptance of the student by the school.
- 4.5.5 The New Student Admission fee is a non-recurring, non-refundable fee which is payable for every new student admitted to ASM and will be paid at the same time as the Registration fee.
- 4.5.6 The Building and Maintenance Fund charge is non-refundable and is payable for each student as per the tuition schedule in force. The Fund is dedicated to the repair and renovation of school buildings and equipment. The amount and applicability of the charge will be determined by the Board of Trustees.
- 4.5.7 Optional Transportation Fee: For those parents who opt for the school-contracted bus service, a Transportation fee will be charged annually. Parents may choose from one of three options for the bus service:
- Full service (morning and afternoon),
 - one-way morning service or
 - one-way afternoon service.
- If a parent selects the one-way only service (morning or afternoon), the transportation rate will be 60% of the full service fee...[for late bus service and after-school activities policies, refer to the annually published after-school activities guide]...In calculating refunds, bus service use for more than five days in a month will be charged as a full month. In the event that the cost of this service increases during the year, supplementary invoices will be issued.
- 4.5.9 As the school generally admits students for the full year and must budget for teachers, books and supplies accordingly, the school cannot offer refunds for early withdrawal. In some extenuating circumstances, a student must withdraw before the close of the school year. In such cases:
- When a student must withdraw before the beginning of school, a 90% tuition refund will be made.
 - If a student withdraws anytime during the first semester, a 40% tuition refund will be made.
 - If the student withdraws any time during the second semester, there will be no tuition refund.
 - There are no refunds for other fees or for the building and maintenance fund.
- 4.5.10 Late Entry to School.
- If a student enters any time in the first semester of the school year, all the fees and charges for the entire year will be payable.
 - If a student enters in the second semester of the school year but before the last quarter, 60% of the tuition fees plus all other fees and charge will be payable.
 - If a student enters during the last quarter of the school year, 35% of the tuition fees plus all other fees and charges will be payable.

Please note in addition: Students may occasionally be required to purchase books and/or consumable materials and pay for external examinations. Cafeteria fees can be billed annually with tuition and payment is due in the same manner as tuition. In the event that the cost of this service increases during the year, supplementary invoices will be issued.
